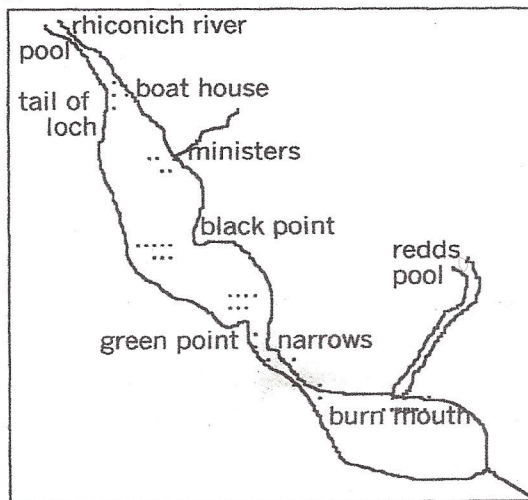


RHICONICH ESTATE

Principal Lochs (O.S Map 9 Cape Wrath)

1. Gharbet Beag: Grid Ref: NC 265507

Salmon, Sea Trout and Brown Trout



Best wind: North West or South East (A good wind is important)

Recommended flies:
Small size 10 or 12

Hairy Mary double Stoats Tail double Elver
Muddler Small Tubes Silver Doctor
Waddingtons Connemara Black Black Pennel
Soldier Palmer

(If all else fails large Collie Dog fished fast!)

Main Lies:

- Pool Worth a try in spate conditions if fish are running
- Tail of Loch Best in high water, first place fish rest, good lie by sunken stone
- Ministers Good Sea Trout lie as well, fish lie close in to the bank
- Black Point Main lie in low water, best fished from boat
- Narrows Best in high water, on its day the best spot on the loch
- Burn Mouth Fish both streams. In high water fish redds pool in burn
- Green Point Fish drop back here from narrows. Quite deep.

n.b NEVER TAKE BOAT THROUGH THE NARROWS

Salmon: Average size 6 – 8lbs. Salmon run June to Sept.

Main Run: Early July.

Best fishing in strong wind, after a spate with water over flat stone at boat house.

In addition there are two or three pools in the Rhiconich River that are worth fishing.

Sea Trout: Plenty of Finnoch, (please return) but very few fish over the 11lb mark (same problem all over Scotland)*

Brown Trout: Good size 8 -12oz.
